## What is Super Summer

First, let me tell you that Super Summer is not for the entire youth group. It is for the few students who meet requirements and are recommended by their youth pastor or pastor. Super Summer is for those students who want to soar on wings as eagles. Students will be compelled to reach beyond their potential and explore God's strength and power.

Super Summer focuses on the leaders from each youth group. It is not for the casual Christian or non-Christian. Super Summer is NOT your average summer youth camp! It is an intensive discipleship driven and development camp for specific teenagers in your church. Super Summer is only available to students that have just completed the 8<sup>th</sup> grade through students who have just recently graduated from high school. Teenagers that come to Super Summer should be a Christian; actively sharing their faith, involved in an on-going small-group Bible study, living a lifestyle that honors Christ, and display a potential for leadership. To help you determine who from your group might be a candidate for Super Summer, we have produced an application form for you to use.

Super Summer exists to inspire and equip students as Kingdom-minded leaders. Super Summer focuses on 5 core values; spiritual growth, Spiritual Disciplines, Leadership, Evangelism, Discipleship, and Service/Ministry.

Super Summer Louisiana will be a training opportunity for youth ministers to bring Christian young people who are interested in advancing their personal spiritual growth. Super Summer will continue to grow as the need for student leaders intensifies.

Super Summer Louisiana is led by an executive team made up of youth ministers, pastors, and laymen. Super Summer Louisiana takes place at Louisiana College in June each year. Weeks will be added as needed.

We hope Super Summer Louisiana will provide a cutting edge vision and resource to churches and youth pastors that will effectively explode this generation of Christian teens into a world that desperately needs hope and salvation. Super Summer participants will be positioned to be at the front of the line for intern and staffer positions at camps and ministry positions.

## Camp Breakdown

Students are divided into schools.

This is done by grade, starting with students completing the 8th grade through students completing their senior year of high school.

Students are given a family group consisting of 1-2 adult leaders and 10-12 students.

Each family group is integrated with students from different churches.

Family groups are intended to facilitate thoughts and conversations of the teaching and provide a "family" atmosphere away from home.

#### Exec. Staff

We have rolled your downloadable resources into the new Super Summer portion of our website. All of this is in preparation to deliver as much as we can to you through the web so that you can have it at your fingertips. You will need to create a username and password to access the site. Super Summer exists to inspire and equip students as Kingdom-minded leaders. Super Summer focuses on 5 core values of spiritual growth, Spiritual Disciplines, Leadership, Evangelism, Discipleship, and Service/Ministry. In order to provide a highly effective camp and a quality environment, anyone who would like to serve on the Executive Staff is required to attend the retreat. Executive Staff may serve in one of four roles to lead their school during the week of camp.

The four roles are: Deans, Assistant Deans, Team Leaders, Team Leader Coordinator. Executive Staff retreat exists to train, inspire, and prepare for Super Summer. During the retreat leaders will worship together, hear a challenging message from keynote camp speaker, attend training session for staff development, meet in teams to coordinate their week of Super Summer and build community prior to working together at camp.

#### Dear Pastor,

Thank you for your interest in the support of Super Summer Louisiana. Our goal and purpose is to provide training to youth pastors and leadership students in the areas of evangelism, discipleship and leadership skills. Because of this, our camp is structured differently than other camps and is designed for a specific type of student. It also requires that we have a specific time of training for anyone in a leadership role to insure everyone understands their part of the mission for the week. We understand the inconvenience this can bring to your church and because of that, we take seriously the responsibility of using that time wisely. That is why we also want to take the time to tell you our purpose and goal of our Team Leader Weekend planning time.

Our belief is by equipping the top leaders in your student ministry, they will be in a position to make a significant impact in the life of your church. In order to do this, we ask that only leadership students be allowed to attend. To help with this, we have set guidelines that can be used to help evaluate a student's readiness concerning attending Super Summer. **During the required interview process** (conducted by the Youth Pastor or Leader), the following criteria should be taken into consideration.

- 1. Has made a commitment to follow Jesus
- 2. Has an active devotional life
- 3. Regularly attends and supports youth ministry events at their home church
- 4. Is an active leader in their total student ministry
- 5. Has a positive witness/testimony outside of church and with their family
- 6. Expresses a willingness to share their faith with their peers

Our second belief is that Super Summer should provide training and spiritual renewal for the leadership involved. This includes youth pastors and volunteer leaders who will be in direct contact with students during the week. Our purpose for team leader weekend is to allow time for the teaching teams to come together as a family while they are learning about their specific responsibilities. One of the great strengths of Super Summer is the interaction in the small group discussion times that are held after each large group teaching session. It is imperative that these small group leaders be adequately prepared to facilitate small groups. We have also found that there is a great need for spiritual renewal and reflection in the lives of our leadership staff before they are called on to pour themselves out into the lives of the students. This is a major emphasis of our team leader weekend which culminates with a consecration service. Because of this, we have come to the conclusion that the team leader weekend, which is held the Saturday and Sunday before the week of camp is a required event. It is virtually impossible for someone to miss this weekend and be in step with or prepared to meet the needs of the students you will be sending.

## REQUIREMENTS AND BENEFITS FOR ALL SUPER SUMMER YOUTH APPLICANTS

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Completed 8<sup>th</sup> grade but not yet in college.
- 2. Agree to attend and participate in all Super Summer sessions and activities.
- 3. Must be a faithful, baptized believer.
- 4. Demonstrates leadership qualities and is a growing Christian.
- 5. Live and actively share their faith consistently.
- 6. Devoted to prayer. Committed to purity and abstinence. Totally drug-free.
- 7. At least 75% attendance at Sunday School.
- 8. Participate in student ministry events (DiscipleNow, retreats, camps, YEC, etc.)
- 9. Has shared personal testimony with youth group before coming to Super Summer each year. All students are expected to share their testimony within their schools and family groups.
- 10. Involved in a small group discipleship study and/or accountability group.
- 11. Memorized at least 10 scripture verses. Students may be asked to recite these verses at Super Summer.
- 12. Write an essay that expresses your level of commitment to Christ and how you are involved in leadership in your church and community. (100 words) This should be given to your youth leader or pastor.
- 13. Two Teacher/Employee References. Use Attached form.

**BENEFITS** – Each student attending Super Summer Louisiana will receive a \$2,500 scholarship for each year they attend Super Summer for a total scholarship of \$10,000.

#### **Super Summer Covenant**

#### CHURCH AND CAMPER REGISTRATION

Super Summer will use this registration packet to get you, your students, and your adults registered for Super Summer. During the registration process, you'll be using this document quite extensively as you prepare to bring your students. We are constantly working to improve our registration process to make it as quick and easy as possible, while maintaining a high standard. In the future, registration will be online.

#### MANAGING REGISTRATION

#### OPENING REGISTRATION

We allow for students to be registered through their church. Supply your forms to your students, give them a deadline to turn them in completed, check to make sure all information is completed, then mail the info to us. Students are not allowed to register themselves.

#### REGISTER YOURSELF

As soon as you have downloaded the registration forms, we encourage you to go ahead and register yourself.

#### **ADULT CAMPERS**

Super Summer relies on adults and college staffers (Team Leaders) to help us execute the logistics of camp. We would love to encourage you and your adult chaperones to help us with the camp experience by being willing to volunteer. There are several ways you can get involved: be a dorm supervisor, run a game at recreation, security, etc. Complete descriptions of the areas we need to cover are available for review when you register for camp.

#### DURING THE REGISTRATION PERIOD

After you give students the forms we encourage you to regularly contact them to ensure they turn in completed forms to you on time. Be sure to cancel the registrations of students who do not turn in forms with their payment.

#### CANCELLATIONS

If a student needs to cancel, you can cancel him/her until the last cancel date, according to the fee structure. Please remember to check the fee structure, as any applicable late fees will be assessed and your church and the student will be responsible for making those payments.

If a student cancels his or her registration and circumstances change allowing him or her to come to camp, the student may be un-cancelled without penalty, provided space is available.

#### **SUBSTITUTIONS**

Once camp is full, the only way to bring in additional students is through substituting a camper who wishes to cancel. Julie will walk you through the process of cancelling the camper who can no longer attend and replacing him or her with the new camper. The cancelling camper will be responsible for any late fees assessed, and the new camper will be responsible for the registration fee at the time they register, based on the fee structure.

#### HOUSING AND ROOMMATES

Because Super Summer understands housing is a critical component to the atmosphere and camp experience, we do our very best to accommodate roommate preferences as they have been supplied by the youth leader. You play a critical role in helping us understand who should be roomed together, because you have personal knowledge about the students who work well together and those who don't. Please pay special attention to the role you play in housing students.

#### **HOW IT WORKS**

Super Summer does not allow co-ed housing, even for adults. We will house all of your students, by gender, in the same dorm. We make every effort to put all of your students in rooms adjacent to each other, but in some cases, students may be down the hall or on the floor above or below. Specific details about the housing arrangements will be made available to you when the housing process is complete a couple of weeks before camp.

#### ROOMMATE PAIRINGS

As soon as camp is full, we will ask you to pair your students based on the preferences they have given during the registration process.

Super Summer will give you a specific number of rooms based on the number of students you have, in each gender. You will need to pair the students in groups of 2, although based on the number of students attending, you may have a couple of rooms of 1. If you choose to not pair your students as they have requested, we encourage you to please make sure you have that conversation with the student campers. If you don't, the students will see their roommates when it is publicly released by Super Summer, and we cannot accommodate roommate changes once all housing is complete.

Also, if circumstances allow, we encourage you to avoid housing one student with one adult.

#### ROOMMATE CHANGES

You will have a limited window in which you can make changes to campers and their roommates. After this window is closed, we will be unable to accommodate any roommate change requests.

#### **SCHOOL ASSIGNMENTS**

All Senior High campers are assigned to Schools. Within each School, the students are assigned to a Family Group, led by a college staffer called a Team Leader.

#### **SCHOOLS**

All campers will be divided up into Schools (8-10 students) designated by the colors Red, Orange, Red, Silver and Gold.

Changes in School colors are only allowed during a limited change window AND only if an even swap can occur. After this window, we are unable to accommodate changes in School assignments.

## Super Summer Registration and Procedures

The following information is to answer your questions about the registration process. If you have any further questions, do not hesitate to call Julie Woodrum at 318.448.3402. Because space is limited, get your Registration Packet (complete with all forms and money) in to the Super Summer Office as soon as possible. Once housing is full, registration will be closed. Please make sure the students you register are going to attend.

#### A FEW SIMPLE RULES

- 1. All students <u>must attend the entire week</u> of activities.
- 2. There is absolutely no leaving the campus for any reason (except a medical emergency and accompanied by SS staff) during the week.
- 3. Absolutely no drugs, tobacco, or alcohol of any kind will be allowed. Any student found possessing such items will be sent home immediately at parents' expense.
- 4. Students should come with teachable spirits, willing hearts, and smiles on their faces.
- 5. Students must attend all class sessions, break-out sessions and worship services.
- 6. Students must follow all on campus rules and expectations.
- 7. Every church must have an **ON CAMPUS Contact Person** in case of a student emergency from their church. This can be exec. staff, team leader, dorm parent, etc.
- 8. Students will be responsible for all lost or misplaced keys (\$50.00) upon checkout on Friday.

#### FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The registration fee includes lodging, meals, materials, and program costs.

Students should plan to bring extra spending money for CDs, soft drinks, snacks, souvenirs, etc. The fees for Super Summer are as follows: \$200.00 per Student -\$155.00 per Team Leader - \$135.00 per Executive Staff Make checks payable to Louisiana Baptist Conv. **REFUND POLICY**

#### **SCHOOL REIMBURSEMENT POLICY**

To receive the School Reimbursement, all forms and receipts must be in by June 15. Each school will only receive one reimbursement check written to a church.

#### DATES FOR REGISTRATION

Registration for Louisiana churches opens Thursday, Feb. 1, 2018, and Thursday, April 1, 2018, for out-of-state churches. (Out-of-state churches must be approved by the Super Summer Director and Board.) Registration closes May 5, 2018, or when the week is full. All monies and forms must be postmarked by May 5th to avoid late fees. ANY PACKET POSTMARKED AFTER MAY 5th MUST PAY A LATE FEE OF \$25 PER STUDENT. Please pass this fee on to the student. All church registration materials in their entirety must be received no later than Friday, May 5th. Your church will be registered only if your Registration Packet is complete with the following: Check list, all student and staff forms, student and team leader interviews, exec. staff and team leader background check forms, room assignments, Church Contact Sheet and payment in FULL. We operate on a first come, first serve basis. If your packet is incomplete, your church will not be registered until all items have been completed and received.

#### **REGISTRATION FORMS**

Please see that each camper's registration form is completed, properly signed by parent/guardian and is legible. Please make sure the forms are not printed on the backs of any pages and the paperwork is stapled correctly in order for the paperwork to be distributed correctly. Each registration form must be accompanied with the Student Interview. PLEASE NOTE: The Student Interview, Team Leader Interview and Team Leader and Executive Staff background forms are absolutely mandator. Each Youth Pastor or Youth Leader takes full responsibility for the students they

The copy of the insurance card is required because if a student has to have medical attention the medical institution must see the card. Information from the card isn't enough.

#### **Super Summer Dress Code**

Super Summer exist to inspire and equip students as Kingdom-minded leaders. With that in mind, we expect the students and leaders to dress with modesty.

#### **TEAM LEADER INFORMATION**

(College age group leader)

Our Team Leaders are a vital part of Super Summer and must attend Team Leader training weekend (Saturday and Sunday before their camp week). They serve as encouragers, discussion leaders, friends and dorm supervisors to a group of 10 to 12 students. During the week, Team Leaders become a small group leader to our students and minister to each student. This assignment demands a spiritually mature and growing person. Make sure the people you send are above reproach, walking with God and of good moral character.

#### **CHURCH REQUIREMENTS**

Each church sending students must provide Team Leaders. The formula for numbers is based on one (1) Team Leader for every seven (7) students. [i.e.: 1 to 7 students requires 1 Team Leader; 8 to 14 students requires 2 Team Leaders etc.]

PLEASE NOTE: If for some reason you cannot find a Team Leader for your group, YOU MUST

STILL PAY FOR THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF TEAMLEADERS REGISTRATION. Work very hard to meet the 1 to 7 ratio. This is vital to our success. Exec Staff persons do not count toward the ratio.

## TEAM LEADER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Be recommended by their Pastor/Youth Pastor
- 2. Be a spiritually mature/growing person who has been out of high school at least one year at the start of Super Summer
- 3. Be a happy, positive person
- 4. Have a heart for young people and be willing to invest his/her life in the lives of students
- 5. Obey the rules of Super Summer
- 6. Be willing to lead in small group discussions Following, prayer, large group teaching
- 7. Attend the Team Leader Training Weekend the Saturday, Sunday and Monday before Super Summer begins. The dates for the Team Leader Training are as follows:

**Attendance** – All persons should arrive during The registration times. (Exec/TLs on Saturday And students on Monday.) For emergency and extenuating circumstances please contact the Super Summer Director, Steve Maltempi -Steve.maltempi@lbc.org.

Saturday, June 4, 1:00pm – 10pm Sunday, June 5, 1:00pm – 10pm Monday, June 6, 8:30am - 11:00am

MANDATORY: All Team Leaders (college age) should check in at the Student Center by 12:00pm on the Saturday of Team Leader Weekend. Room assignments and schedules will be given at that time. Team Leaders must stay on campus and carry out all assigned responsibilities until Friday afternoon of their week. Bring your bedding and other necessary items for the week (towels, pillow, soap, etc.). Team Leaders MUST attend all training sessions and the entire week of the school. There are no exceptions to this rule.

#### BASIC SCHOOL INFORMATION

**Red School** - For all students entering 9th Grade in the fall of 2018

**Orange School** - For all students entering 10<sup>th</sup> Grade in the fall of 2018

Silver School - For all students entering 11th Grade in the fall of 2018

**Gold School** - For all students entering 12th Grade/just graduated in the fall of 2018

**Camouflage School** – For all adult leaders

Ages for the individual schools sometimes change depending on registration numbers that particular year.

#### **DRESS CODE**

The Super Summer dress code is intended to provide an equitable dress code for all campers that encourage modesty above legalism. Parents and church leaders are urged to see that only clothing that meets the policies and regulations of the camp and campus is brought to Louisiana College. Please do not bring to Louisiana College clothing that you sense would be questionable for a Christian camp setting.

Since Louisiana College is a Christian institution with a distinctly Christian atmosphere, the New Testament principle of modesty should always be the standard for dress at Louisiana College. It is the responsibility of the sponsors from each church to model the standard and enforce the camp dress code.

While on the campus of Louisiana College, campers may not wear tank tops, apparel that exposes the midriff, or extremely tight fitting clothing. Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances or inappropriate language/images. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times outside dorms, except while swimming.

While going to and from the swimming areas, ladies must wear shoes and long covering over their swimsuits. Modest swimming suits are appropriate while swimming. A dark t-shirt must be worn over two-piece swimming suits. Men should not wear tight fitting swimsuits and they must wear shoes and a t-shirt with their swimming suit while going to and from the swimming area.

Shorts, dresses and skirts should be modest in length. Slits in dresses and skirts are also to be modest in length. Modest shorts are allowed any time of the day, except during the evening Celebration service. Jeans, pants, slacks, dresses and skirts of appropriate length are acceptable during the evening Celebration service.
